Having moved to Kaikōura as an 8 year old, this amazing small town has been my playground for as long as I can remember. Being a sponsored surfer from the age of 15 and developing an interest in collecting kaimoana (seafood) through diving and fishing, my passion for the moana (ocean) naturally grew.

**The joy I received from showing visiting friends the incredible Kaikōura landscapes and the respect I had for the local marine wildlife after countless special encounters birthed the idea to combine the two and give visitors an intimate local experience of my backyard.**

After a holiday to Australia introduced me to Hobie Pedal Kayaks I was sold and knew I had the perfect way to explore the rugged and beautiful Kaikōura coastline in the least invasive way possible. After obtaining my marine mammal viewing permit I focused on the intelligent and entertaining New Zealand fur seal which occupies the peninsula as well as an abundance of seabirds and penguins. The hands-free pedal kayaks meant guests were constantly wowed with the ability to get close to marine life and photograph them effortlessly.

Seal Kayak Kaikōura is still family owned and operated by my wife and I and we have surrounded ourselves with a team of passionate guides who help us to lead the best small group wildlife tours Kaikōura has to offer.

## SEAL KAYAK TOUR

Let us take you on an adventure, exploring the Kaikōura peninsula's coastline whilst taking in the awe inspiring Kaikōura ranges from the water. Revel in the excitement of having an intimate encounter with NZ fur seals (Kekeno) both on the land and in the ocean.

The unique pedal system that powers you round the ocean is silent and gives you the greatest opportunity to view wildlife such as seals, penguins and native seabirds without disturbing them.

The tour combines both local indigenous history and post-colonial whaling and sealing alongside the most informative small tour wildlife experience Kaikōura has to offer.

# SUNSET KAYAK TOUR

Come and experience Kaikōura's only true sunset experience! Evenings on the water are truly special, with mesmerizing views of the sun setting behind the Kaikōura seaward ranges. Perfectly capture the vistas from your hands-free pedal kayak.

This is our most popular tour, and has given tourists memories that live deep in their New Zealand travels. Seals and other awesome wildlife encounters top off the experience, with expertly guided commentary from a local guide.

**SEASONS:** September to May

**TOUR DEPARTURES:** 6:30pm (December, January)  
5-6:30pm - Varying departure times due to sunset time (September, November, February, March, April).

**DURATION:** Allow 3 hours with 1.5-2 hours on the water

**TOUR SIZES:** 1:8 guide ratio and a maximum of 16 pax per tour slot. No minimum booking size.

**AGE MINIMUM:** 7 year old age minimum.

Expect a range of migrating wildlife and seabirds that aren't able to be spotted at any other time of the year as well as the ever present and playful New Zealand fur seal.

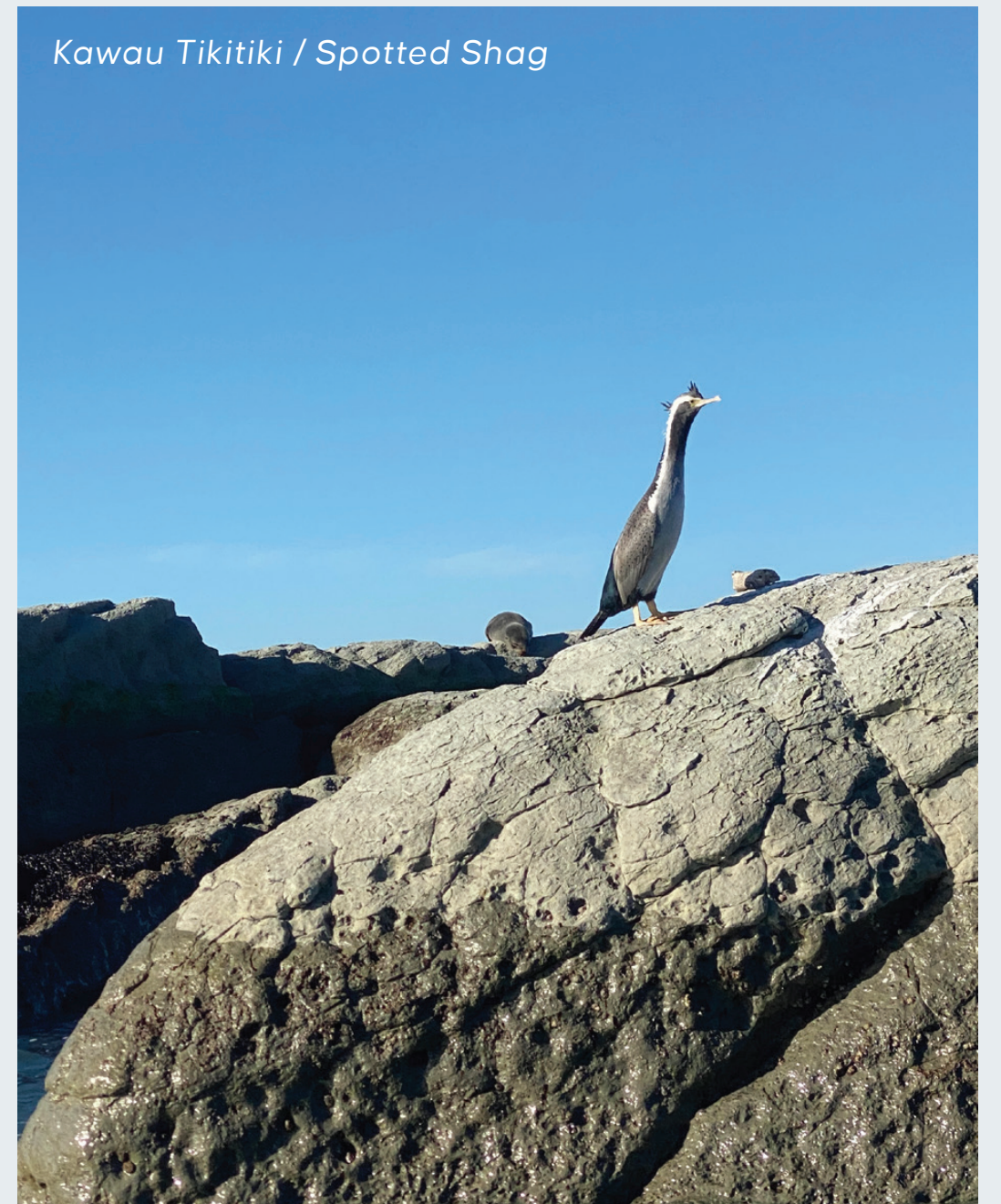
