

Kaikōura is regarded as one of the world's hotspots for viewing pelagic (ocean-going) birdlife with up to ten species of albatross able to be found at various times of year.

The local marine environment is home to more seabird species in a compact area than anywhere else in NZ which has a huge appeal for whether an avid birdwatcher, wildlife enthusiast or keen photographer.

Albatross Encounter provides close up views of a diverse array of seabirds including albatross, petrels, shearwaters, shags, terns and other species... all within close proximity of the Kaikōura Peninsula.

Within just 15 minutes travel time by boat; it is possible to encounter a number of albatross.
