



Kaikōura is the best place in New Zealand to encounter wild dusky dolphins in their natural environment.

The success rate both for locating and swimming with the dolphins in Kaikōura is higher than in any other area in New Zealand.

The number of dolphins vary depending on the time of year and weather conditions but generally pods of 100 to 1000 dolphins can be found along the Kaikōura Coast.

Seasonality: All year round (subject to suitable weather, sea conditions)

Departures: Winter: 1 tour per day

Summer: 3 tours per day

Min 6 pax to guarantee departure

Tour Duration: 4 hours

Options available: Swim or watch

Everyone travels on the same boat

Time in the water: Swimmers should have a good level of water confidence and previous

snorkelling experience and previous snorkelling experience an advantage. Approximately 30 minutes in the

water on average.

Minimum age: Watch: 3 years old

Swim: 8 years old

Infants < 3 y.o not permitted aboard Child rates apply from 3 to 14 y.o

What we provide:

A full wetsuit, hood, snorkel, mask and fins. In winter months additional gear is supplied (gloves, booties). Return transportation from base to the Marina.

What to bring:

Warm clothing, sunscreen and a camera or smart phone to capture the action! If swimming, they should bring a swimsuit, a towel and a bag for their clothing.
