# **Getting there**

The Kahutara PurePod is perched high above the Kahutara River with vast views across to the mighty Seaward Kaikōura Mountain Range. It is only 20 minutes inland from Kaikōura and 2.5 hours north of Christchurch.

## Off the road

Driving into the Kahutara PurePod carpark is the start of your unique PurePod adventure as you ford small streams on your way to the secure carpark near the farmhouse.


## Walk & unwind

From the carpark, the walk is 15 minutes (900m). The walk takes you through beautiful native bush and wetlands. As you reach Kahutara PurePod you get a feeling of awe looking north across the river to the Seaward Kaikōura range.


The Kahutara PurePod is perched high above the Kahutara River, after which this PurePod is named. The mountains rising above the river are part of the Seaward Kaikōura Range which dominates the landscape in the Kaikōura region, along with the nearby coastline with its abundance of marine life.

Explore the marked trails on the steep hills behind the PurePod, reaching heights of 500 meters. Add an optional picnic lunch to your booking and venture up the track for magnificent views.

An added benefit of the Kahutara PurePod is your own "private" range of foothills bordering the opposite side of the river. While the river is a hundred metres away, down below, you will still hear it in the stillness and its sounds will lull you to sleep at night.

#### FEATURES

- Glass roof, perfect for sky & stargazing, and three large glass sliding doors for uninterrupted views.
- The deck is the perfect spot for relaxing in the luxury camp chairs and taking in the stunning views or grilling on the BBQ.
- Fabulous shower and bathroom with beautiful views.
- Blinds & shower curtains available but you will want to keep the windows clear so you can soak in the view.
- Kitchenette, with cooktop, cooking utensils, fridge, cooking oil, salt, pepper, tea, coffee, sugar, fresh drinking water.
- Uber comfortable bed with crisp linen.
- Solar powered plus a fabulous heating system to ensure you stay nice and warm.
- Books, games, USB speaker, telescope, star map.
- No wifi, no phone signal, no power plugs (but there is a USB port for charging your devices).















### Kokomea, Kāpiti Coast

Located on a beautiful grapevine nursery with stunning sunset views across to Kāpiti Island, this PurePod is just an hour drive north of Wellington.



#### Pāmu, Rotorua

Located in a region brimming with cultural, environmental and historical diversity, this is a peaceful retreat within lush verdant farmland and only 15 minutes from Rotorua township.



#### Kahutara, Kaikōura

Perched high above the Kahutara River with vast views across to the mighty Seaward Kaikōura mountain range, this PurePod is only 20 minutes inland from Kaikōura or 2.5 hours from Christchurch.



#### Manakau, Kaikōura

Situated in a vast landscape with sweeping and dramatic views of the Seaward Kaikōura mountain range, only 20 minutes inland from Kaikōura or 2.5 hours from Christchurch.




#### Atatū, Greta Valley

On a historic Greta Valley sheep farm, with sweeping 360-degree views of the sea, rolling hills and native forest, only 90 minutes from Christchurch.



#### Korimako, Greta Valley

Nestled amongst native bush filled with birdsong. This PurePod overlooks a beautiful sea view towards Motunau Island and is 90 minutes north-east of Christchurch.



#### Greystone, Waipara

Hidden above a beautiful organic winery in Waipara, the subtle hues and light shifts create a golden glow on the landscape and is less than an hour drive from Christchurch .



#### Pōhue, Banks Peninsula

An hour drive from Christchurch, with beautiful views of the historic Port Levy bay and surrounded by rolling hills and magnificent rocky outcrops.



#### Haurapa, Cromwell

Absolute tranquility and panoramic vistas of rugged raw rock landscapes are less than an hour from Wanaka & Queenstown. This is an ideal vantage point for breathtaking sunsets and mountain range views.



#### Hananui, Rakiura Stewart Island

Sitting pretty in a conservation reserve, behind a predator proof fence within the southernmost Dark Sky Sanctuary. Flora and fauna thrive here.



#### Tāima, Cromwell

Breathtaking views of the rocky Kawarau Gorge and rugged mountains are less than an hour from Wanaka & Queenstown and offer some of the most spectacular scenery in Central Otago.



Tokoeka, Rakiura Stewart Island

Nestled in native bush behind a predator proof fence in a conservation reserve, within the southernmost Dark Sky Sanctuary. This is the home of the kiwi.
