








Whale Watch is a multiple award winning nature tourism company owned and operated by the indigenous Kāti Kuri people of Kaikōura, a Māori sub-tribe of the South Island's larger Ngai Tahu Tribe.




Whale Watch was formed in 1987 at a time when Maori were casualties of Kaikōura's declining economy. At this time of difficulty, Kāti Kuri leaders like the late Bill Solomon believed the local Sperm Whales held the answer to the unemployment problems of the Māori community. They knew their ancestor Paikea had journeyed to a new life in New Zealand on the back of the whale Tohorā. It seemed appropriate for Paikea's descendants to again ride on the back of the whale to a new life.

And so it proved to be.

The founders of Whale Watch mortgaged their houses to secure a loan to start the business. In the early day's passengers travelled aboard a small inflatable vessel. In time, the inflatable was replaced by a larger boat with an upper viewing deck - the Uruao - until today the Whale Watch fleet numbers 3 modern catamarans each specially designed for whale watching. The expansion of the Whale Watch fleet required the building of an entire marina in South Bay. It is from here that all whale watching tours now depart.

Paikea and Tohorā still form the symbolic centre of Whale Watch. They represent the spiritual bond between the human world and the natural world and speak of the possibilities that reveal themselves when the world of nature is revered rather than exploited.

WHALE WATCH AT A GLANCE




Whale Watch Kaikōura is located 2.5 hours north of Christchurch & 2 hours south of Picton. We are considered New Zealand's ultimate marine life experience.

Key Points: Vessels crewed by skilled staff capable of providing an indigenous, scientific and local interpretation making it a totally unique experience.

95% success rate in sighting whales backed up by an 80% refund if the tour does not sight a whale.


Tours operate all year round along stunning coast environment with amazing mountains as a backdrop.

Highlights: Close encounters with the Giant Sperm Whales. A typical Whale Watch tour may encounter NZ Fur Seals, pods of Dusky Dolphins, and the endangered Wandering Albatross. Dependent on the season you may also see migrating Humpback Whales, Pilot Whales & Southern Right Whales, as well as Orca.





DID YOU KNOW?



The Giant Sperm Whale is the star of the show and is resident in the area all year round. In addition to the Sperm Whale, a number of different species of whales have been sighted off our coastline, including Blues, Humpbacks, Rights and Orca.

As well as sighting whales, a typical trip will cruise by colonies of New Zealand Fur Seals and perhaps take in groups of dolphins, depending on the season



In addition to the marine mammals, Kaikōura has a wide variety of offshore birds. These include Albatross, Shearwaters, Petrels, Gulls, Penguins and Gannets.



WHALE WATCH WAKA



Our vessels are designed specially for whale watching, our modern catamarans are equipped with engines that minimise underwater noise and toilets that never pollute the sea.

The passenger cabins are enclosed with large outside decks offering great viewing and photo opportunities.



Spacious air-conditioned interiors are fitted with comfortable seating while large TV screens display our award-winning marine wildlife animations and 3D animated live tracking system.

Passengers numbers for each tour are kept well below our vessel carrying capacity to ensure your tour experience remains a personal one

Each vessel holds a current Certificate of Survey and operates a Safe Ship Management Programme.

Whale Watch vessels are crewed by experienced teams familiar with local sea conditions and well versed in all safety procedures.

All skippers hold appropriate marine qualifications. All crew hold First Aid Certificates.

Whale Watch staff constantly monitor the weather and respond professionally to any changes.

This may mean a tour is cancelled or safety restrictions placed on children or passengers with medical problems.

Passenger comfort and safety are always our priority.

Incorporating current and new technology to improve visitor experience, such as: Sickle Bow hull design to improve sea keeping capabilities Adjustable hydrofoil system to improve vessel performance and sea keeping capabilities Naiad Dynamic Active Interceptor Ride Control System to improve sea keeping capabilities by reducing pitch and roll motion.





OCEANS CABIN



This passenger cabin is enclosed, with seating for 104 passengers.


There are three large screen displays throughout the cabin that showcase our award- winning marine wildlife animations along with our latest 3D animated live tracking system.

VIP CAPTAINS CABIN




The VIP Captains Cabin is situated in the wheelhouse alongside the skipper and watch-keeper.

This cabin provides our guests with exclusive transfers to and from the marina with priority embarking and disembarking of the vessel. VIP Captain's Cabin guest have an excusive viewing deck situated on the upper deck, as well as a dedicated guide for the duration of their tour.



Capacity is 12 passengers maximum- locally sourced food boxes and non-alcoholic beverages are also served in the captains cabin.

Once you're feeling well again, you're free to remove the headset and enjoy your journey.

Should seasickness symptoms recur, simply reapply the headset.

Small, lightweight and portable, each See-LEVEL headset can provide up to two hours of treatment on a single charge.

We are currently carrying 10 headsets on each boat.

WHEEL CHAIR ACCESIBLE

TE AO MARAMA & WHEKETERE - Once wheeled on to the bow of the vessel there are 3 steps down on to the lower deck. There is a raised lip as we enter into the main cabin, This lip has a rubber cover that allows a wheelchair to enter with ease.

The two front seats on either the port or the right of the vessel allows for great viewing. Your captain will do their best to keep the windows clear and place marine life sightings on the side of the vessel you are seated. There is space between the rows of seating to wheel a chair through the cabin with plenty of space on the back deck (the stern to move around) keeping in mind there will be other quests on board.

We have a specially built toilet for easy access for our guests in a wheelchair.





DO I NEED TO BOOK IN ADVANCE?

Yes - There is a high demand for most of our trips, so we advise that you book your seat 3-4 days ahead of time during peak season (November-April) at least 2 days ahead in the off-peak season.

HOW LONG IS THE TOUR?

Time spent on the water is just over 2 hours. Including check-in time, safety briefing and bus transfers you should allow 3 hours 15 minutes in total

WHAT HAPPENS IF THE SEA AND WEATHER CONDITIONS ARE NOT SUITABLE?

Our passengers safety and comfort are of paramount importance to us. If the conditions are not suitable, we will cancel the tour. Passengers, who are travelling to join us on the day of their tour, are advised to telephone the free phone number for a conditions update



IF THE TOUR IS CANCELLED, ARE PASSENGERS AUTOMATICALLY TRANSFERRED TO THE NEXT ONE?

No - When a tour is cancelled, we will do our best to accommodate the guest on another one. The guest does need to request this.

WHAT ARE YOUR TOUR TIMES?

Summer months: 7.15am, 8:00am, 10.00am, 10:45am, 12.45pm, 1:30pm, 3:30pm, 4:15pm —these are check-in times only - please do not ask your clients to come earlier than the times specified.

During the winter months (May - Oct) we book the 10.00am tour first and then other tour times when demand dictates. Typically we would run maximum 7:15am, 10am, 12:45pm

EXCLUSIVE CHARTER

Exclusive tour charters are offered all year round but will be dependent on the availability of an entire vessel at the time being requested.

Exclusive tour charter bookings can only be made directly with customer services staff. Exclusive tour charters (unless otherwise agreed to by WWK) are only operated on standard WWK tour times.

On Te Ao Marama & Wheketere an exclusive tour charter can be for 1-12 pax in the Captains Cabin & 1-104 in the Ocean Cabin. The Captains Cabin (12 Seats) can be chartered exclusively on a tour. Standard booking and payment conditions apply. Commission can apply to bookings made through an approved agent. 80% no whale sighting refund policy applies. Standard group discounts or any other deals and promotions will not apply for Exclusive tour charters.

The following structure is based on confirmed numbers and also based on the current rack rate.

Number of pax in group for tour leader discount:

1-5 (incl) = 20%

5-10 (incl) = 30%

11-14 (incl) = 50%

15+ = 100% + 1 free seat

ONE SEAT FOC FOR CONFIRMED NUMBERS ABOVE 15PAX. THIS MUST BE REQUESTED AT THE TIME THE RESERVATION IS MADE.

A tour leader, escort, guide, and/or coach driver may book on a *stand-by basis at any time.

During peak season (Nov - April) we recommend confirmed reservations be made for tour leaders, escorts, guides and/or coach drivers, as there is a very high demand for our tour.
